Dr. Mauro Pittiruti MD.

Dr. Mauro Pittiruti was born in 1954 and lives in Rome. He has been working as a surgeon at the Catholic University Hospital since 1980. From 1990 on, he has focused most of his clinical and scientific activity on venous access devices, becoming one of the leading international experts in this area. Since 1998, he is the chairman of the Italian Group for Venous Access Devices (GAVeCeLT). Since 2000, he is one of the chief editors of the Journal of Vascular Access. Since 2010, he is chairman of the Scientific Committee of WoCoVA (World Conference on Vascular Access). In 2009, he received the Suzanne Herbst Award for Excellence in Vascular Access. During the last decades, he has lectured in hundreds of meetings all over the world; he has published three volumes on venous access and more than 400 papers, 150 of which are indexed on PubMed.



Mr. Ton Van Boxtel RN, MSc, Vc-BC, PAN certified

Mr. Ton Van Boxtel has more than 35 years' experience in nursing with a background in hematology/BMT and 6 years as a Nurse Specialist in the UMC Utrecht pain team. He was the President of EBMT-NG 1989-1997. Mr. Ton was a Nurse Specialist and unit-leader in charge of a home infusion team from 1992-2010. Since 2010 he has been the owner of Infusion Innovations for training Vascular Access and Infusion Technology. Mr. Ton Van Boxtel had introduced PICC in Netherlands in 1997 and has been a Vascular Access specialist since 2000. Besides having done numerous presentations, workshops and publications, Mr. Ton was the President of the Dutch society for infusion technology since 2003. He was the congress president and organizer of biennial World Congress on Vascular Access (WoCoVA) since 2010. He also has been a Reviewer for the Journal of Vascular Access (JVA) since June 2015.
